

# "TRAD" JACKETS (in 4 sizes) in Lavenda Double Six

To obtain the best results, use the Lister qualities specified. Be sure to use the correct size for your garment, otherwise you may have difficulty.

## Materials

30 (32, 34, 36) ozs. LAVENDA DOUBLE SIX.

Pair each needles Nos. 6 and 7.

5 (5, 5, 5) Buttons.

1½ yds. of 2 inch wide Petersham ribbon.

3 Stitch Holders.

## Measurements

To fit 34/36 (36/38, 38/40, 40/42) ins. Bust (Chest) measurement.

Length from shoulder .. .. . 25½ (26½, 27½, 28½) ins.

Length of undersleeve seam .. .. . 18 (18½, 19, 20) ins.

## Tension

5 sts. and 9 rows equal one inch (No. 6 needles).

N.B.—The tension of the knitting controls the size of the finished garment. Before commencing cast on 12 sts. and work in pattern for 20 rows. If your sample has less sts. per inch than our tension, try again with smaller needles and vice versa, then work the garment on the needles which produce our tension.

## BACK

Using No. 6 needles cast on 84 (88, 94, 98) sts.

**Next row.** Purl.

Now work pattern as follows.

**1st row.** (Right side) slip one Knitwise, WF \* P1, slip one purlwise, keeping wool to front, repeat from \* to last st., WB, K1.

**2nd row.** K1, Purl to last st., K1.

**3rd row.** Slip one knitwise, WF \* Slip one purlwise, keeping wool to front P1, repeat from \* to last st., WB, K1.

**4th row.** As 2nd row.

These 4 rows form the pattern.

Continue in pattern until work measures 2½ (2½, 2½, 2½) ins.

Continue in pattern increasing one st. at both ends of next row and at both ends of rows when work measures 5 ins., 7½ ins., 10 ins., 12½ ins. and 15 ins. from beginning 96 (100, 106, 110) sts. (Taking extra sts. into pattern). Continue on these sts. until work measures 16 (16½, 17, 17½) ins.

## SHAPE ARMHOLES.

Cast off 4 (6, 6, 6) sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, and 4 (4, 6, 6) sts. at beginning of next 2 rows.

Continue on remaining 80 (80, 82, 86) sts. until work measures 24½ (25½, 26½, 27½) ins.

## SHAPE SHOULDERS.

Cast off 6 (6, 6, 6) sts. at beginning of next 6 rows, then 5 (5, 5, 5) sts. at beginning of next 2 rows, then 4 (4, 4, 4) sts. at beginning of next 2 rows.

Cast off remaining 26 (26, 28, 30) sts.

## POCKET LININGS (3 required)

Using No. 7 needles cast on 26 (28, 30, 32) sts. and work in st.st. (1st row—knit) until work measures 4 (4, 4, 4) ins. ending with a purl row.

Leave these sts. on a stitch holder.

## RIGHT FRONT

Using No. 6 needles cast on 50 (54, 56, 60) sts.

**Next row.** Purl.

Now work in pattern for 4 (4, 6, 6) rows.

## WOMANS JACKET ONLY (Make buttonhole).

**Next row.** Pattern 4, cast off 4, pattern to end.

**Next row.** Pattern to last 4 sts., cast on 4 sts., pattern 4.

Make further buttonholes 5½ (5¾, 5¾, 6) ins. above cast off edge of previous one until there are 5 in all.

## MANS JACKET ONLY.

Work 2 more rows in pattern.
