Casting on-Thumb Method

2 yards from the end twist the wool round the left thumb to make a loop and knit this loop onto the needle from the ball of wool. Repeat till required number of sts. are on the needle making the loop from the 2 yards and knitting from the ball. method of casting on should always be used.

Abbreviations

K .- Knit; P .- Purl; Sts .- Stitches;

Ins.-Inches:

St.st.-Stocking st., which is the smooth side of one row knit one row purl;

WF.-Wool Forward; WB.-Wool Back;

K2IN.-Knit twice into st. i.e. into front and then into back of st.

To work larger sizes follow figures in parenthesis ().

MANS AND WOMANS JACKETS.

When work measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. from beginning and ending with a wrong side row. Increase one st. at end of next row, then continue until work measures 5 ins. from beginning ending with a row on wrong side.

Next row. Pattern to last st., K2IN.

Next row. K1, P9, (11, 11, 13) cast off next 26 (28, 30, 32) sts. purlwise. Purl to last st., K1.

Next row. Pattern 16, then with right side facing pattern across sts. of one pocket lining, pattern 10 (12, 12, 14) ★★ Continue increasing at side edge when work measures $7\frac{1}{2}$ ins., 10 ins., $12\frac{1}{2}$ ins., and 15 ins. from beginning, 56 (60, 62, 66) sts.

Continue on these sts. until work measures 16 ($16\frac{1}{2}$, 17, $17\frac{1}{2}$) ins. ending at side edge.

SHAPE ARMHOLE.

Cast off 4 (6, 6, 6) sts. at beginning of next row, then 4 (4, 6, 6) sts. at beginning of next alternate row 48 (50, 50, 54) sts.

Continue on these sts. until work measures 23 (24, 24¹/₂, $25\frac{1}{2}$) ins. ending at front edge.

SHAPE NECK.

Cast off 10 (12, 10, 12) sts. at beginning of next row, then decrease one st. at same edge on next 11 (11, 13, 14) rows, 27 (27, 27, 28) sts.

Work 1 (1, 3, 2) rows more.

SHAPE SHOULDER.

Cast off 6 (6, 6, 6) sts. at beginning of next and alternate row three times, then cast off 5 (5, 5, 5) sts. at beginning of next alternate row.

Work one row more.

Cast off remaining 4 (4, 4, 5) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using No. 6 needles cast on 50 (54, 56, 60) sts.

Next row. Purl.

Now work in pattern for 4 (4, 6, 6) rows.

MANS JACKET ONLY (Make buttonhole).

Next row. Pattern to last 8 sts., cast off 4 sts. pattern to

Next row. Pattern 4, cast on 4 sts. Pattern to end.

Make further buttonhole $5\frac{1}{2}$ ($5\frac{3}{4}$, $5\frac{3}{4}$, 6) ins. above cast off edge of previous one until there are 5 in all.

WOMANS JACKET ONLY.

Work 2 rows more in pattern.

MANS AND WOMANS JACKETS.

When work measures 2½ ins. from beginning, ending with a row on wrong side. Increase one st. at beginning of next row, then continue until work measures 5 ins. from beginning, ending with a row on wrong side.
